Weekly Club Guide

Lesson 1: [“God So Loved the World”](#) (click to watch)

Main Idea: When Jesus died on the cross, He made a way for us to be forgiven of our sin. When we believe in Jesus as Savior and Lord, we become a part of God’s family.

Key Verse: “For God so loved the world, that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.”

John 3:16

Ask These Questions:

1. **What does it mean to *believe* something?** (It means to know for sure that something is true. When we believe the Bible, or believe Jesus, we believe that everything they say is TRUE!)
2. **Who is Jesus?** (Jesus is God’s only Son. He is God and lived before anything was created. He came to earth and lived like us so that we could know God’s love.)
3. **What does it mean that Jesus is our Lord?** (Because Jesus is God, He is in control of everything! We can trust what He says because He is all powerful. We obey Him and love Him because He is God.)
4. **What does it mean that Jesus is our Savior? What did He do to save us?** (Because we sin, and do wrong things that we know are bad, we can’t know God on our own. Our sins have to be paid for first. God loves us so much that He sent Jesus to pay for our sins! He died on the cross and paid for us, so we can be forgiven and not have to pay.)
5. **How can we be saved by Jesus?** (When we trust Jesus and admit we need His forgiveness, we become a part of God’s family forever and are saved from our sin.)

Try This Activity:

Have your Spark(s) list some wrong things they have done. Ask them if Jesus can forgive them for all of those wrong things (yes!). Then have him/her describe something mean that someone else did to them in the past. Have them pray again and thank Jesus that He loves that person and can forgive them, too. Invite them to pray the prayer of salvation and ask Jesus to become their Savior and Lord.
