Lesson 16: ["Jesus is Fully God"](#) (click to watch)

Main Idea: The Bible says that Jesus is just like God in every way because He is God's Son. This means that Jesus isn't just *like* God, He *is* God. He is one of the 3 persons in the Trinity.

Key Verse: "I and the Father are one."
John 10:30

Ask These Questions:

- 1. What does the Bible say about who Jesus was?** (The Bible says in many different ways that Jesus was God. One way it says this is by telling us that Jesus and the Father are one. This is never said of anyone in the Bible but Jesus.)
- 2. What does it mean that Jesus was fully God?** (It means that Jesus is all-powerful and all knowing, like God the Father. It also means that Jesus has no beginning or end, and that He is perfect and cannot sin.)
- 3. If Jesus was God, how was He also a man?** (Jesus left His throne in heaven to live life as a human. When He did this, He didn't stop being God. Nothing was taken away from who He was, but being human was added to who He was. He was 100% God and 100% man. He has a birthday as a human, but Jesus had always existed even before He was human. He died on the cross, but He rose again and will never die.)
- 4. Was Jesus a human just like us?** (Jesus was like us because He was a human with a real body. He also experienced human things, like being hungry or thirsty, getting sick, and needing to sleep. But He was *different* from us because He was perfect and had no sin. He also had authority over creation that no one else has on their own.)

This Activity:

Have your clubber(s) **get two pieces of fruit** that are *not* the same kind of fruit (a banana and an apple, a mango and a strawberry, etc.). **Hold up the pair** and **ask** "What am I holding in my hands?" After they answer, **respond**, "I'm holding a banana and an apple, 2 things, but I'm also holding fruit, 1 thing. Two things that are also one in a way." **Explain**, "That's similar to how it is with Jesus. He is two things, God and man, but they are made *one* thing in Jesus. Two different things, that are both made one in Him." **Let them know** that it is okay if it's confusing to understand! Have your clubbers **draw pairs** of other things that are in the same category but are different. Examples are a carrot and potato (both are veggies), a sock and a shirt (both are clothes), or Iron Man and Black Panther (both superheroes).
