## Weekly Club Guide

**Lesson 30:** [“Grace to Persevere”](#) (click to watch)

**Main Idea:** Giving up at something means we miss out on the things God wants to show us and give us. Through the Holy Spirit, God empowers us to persevere even when following Him is hard!

**Key Verse:** “Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the Lord your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you.”  
Deuteronomy 31:6

### Ask These Questions:

1. **What does “persevere” mean?** (It means to keep going instead of giving up, even when it’s hard.)
2. **What is something you’ve had to work really hard at?** (Let them try to answer this question. If needed, remind them of a team, project, performance, or difficult family event that they have been a part of.)
3. **Have you ever felt like giving up? Why or why not?** (Ask questions like: What was the hardest part? How did that make you feel? Did you think the end goal was worth it? What would have been the easiest thing to do? What did you see your friends/teammates doing?)
4. **What is God calling you to do?** (Our ultimate goal in life should be to *be like Jesus* in what we say, in what we think, in what we want, and in how we treat others. God calls us to serve Him in specific ways and places, like on a sports team, at home, or with a friend. Is there a way you can serve God by being like Jesus in one of those areas right now?)
5. **How can you keep going, even when it’s hard?** (There will be times when we want to choose something that looks fun or easy instead of following God. Sometimes we will be the only person we know following Him! That’s okay. If you’ve trusted Jesus as your savior, the Holy Spirit is living inside of you. He will give you the strength and power every day to follow Him! That is how you experience the best things in life!)

### Try This Activity:

Have your clubber(s) play **Egg Walk**. Have them hold a **spoon in their mouths** (biting the handle) and place a **raw egg in the spoon**. Have them try to **walk across the yard** without dropping the egg. They have to balance the egg holding the spoon with their mouths only—**no hands!** Have a **prize** (favorite snack, a reward activity, etc.) waiting for them if they’re successful. Multiple tries are okay!  
You can even put some **obstacles** in the way (chairs/balls/cones) and **distract them** with goofy noises!  
**Explain** that sometimes obstacles and distractions make it hard to follow God. But if we know what is in store for us as Christians, we will stay the course and persevere no matter what!
