## Weekly Club Guide

**Main Idea:** We need good instructions. Without them, we are confused and make mistakes. The Bible gives us instructions for how to live and glorify God. It is our instruction book for *life*!

**Key Verse:** “I have hidden Your Word in my heart that I might not sin against You.”  
Psalm 119:11

### Ask These Questions:

- 1. Where do we find God’s instructions for our life?** (In the Bible. The Bible shows us who God is and how He wants us to live. It shows us what God thinks about the problems, changes, and issues we face as people every day. It speaks to every person, in every age and culture, in any situation.)
- 2. What is the first step in God’s instructions?** (We start by knowing Jesus as our savior and our master. That is the first step to knowing God and experiencing His plans for us.)
- 3. What does it mean to really have a relationship with Jesus?** (Knowing Jesus means more than just knowing facts *about* Jesus. Even the devil knows *about* Jesus! Having a *relationship* with Jesus means that we come to Jesus, ask for His forgiveness, and give Him control and ownership of our whole life.)
- 4. What effect does the Bible have on our lives?** (When we study and memorize the Bible, it becomes a guide. It shows us the areas where our lives are pleasing to God, and the areas where we need to change and grow. It makes us see ourselves the way God sees us and transforms us to live like Jesus lived.)

### Try This Activity:

Have your clubber(s) **get an instruction manual** for something (a lego set, video game, board game, etc.). **Ask them**, “Do you need this manual? How important is it? What would happen if you didn’t have it? What would happen if you only read every other page? What would happen if you started in the middle and skipped the beginning?” **Ask** them why people write instruction manuals for things. Then **ask**, “Which is more important: Life, or (the game/toy that the manual was for)? *How much* more important?” **Tell** them that the Bible is our instruction manual for life. Just like we shouldn’t skip around or ignore the manual that they found, we shouldn’t do that with the Bible, either. If we ignore God’s instructions, the consequences will be *much* more serious than for a toy or game! The world has a lot of hurt and confusion, but God has made a way for Christians to walk through those problems with clarity, peace and excitement: it’s the Bible!
