

# SPARKS

## Weekly Club Guide

**Main Idea:** God's Word, the Bible, lasts forever. Even the promises that He made thousands of years ago are still true! God always tells the truth and He always keeps His promises.

**Key Verse:** "The grass withers and the flower falls, but the Word of the Lord remains forever."  
1 Peter 1:24

### Ask These Questions:

1. **Can we trust things God said a long time ago?** (Yes! Everything that God has ever said will be true forever. God's promises never stop being true.)
2. **Who was Noah?** (Noah was a man who loved God, even when no one around him did. His story is in Genesis 6-9, at the beginning of the Bible and the beginning of history).
3. **What did God tell Noah?** (God told Noah to build a giant boat called an "ark." After the ark was built, God said that He would bring animals to the ark so that Noah and his family and the animals could get inside. Then, God would send a flood that would cover everything—even mountains!—to judge the world for people's sin.)
4. **What happened to Noah?** (God kept His promise! He protected Noah and his family and the animals from the flood while they were in the ark. Then, the waters went down, and everyone left the ark.)
5. **What did God promise to Noah?** (God promised that He would never flood the whole world ever again. We learn in Noah's story that God always keeps His promises!)

### Try This Activity:

It's time to build an ark and have a flood! Have your clubber(s) gather things from around the house to **build an "ark."** You can use blankets, pillows, chairs (think "pillow fort!"), etc. Once they are inside, have them **make the sounds of a storm** by blowing like the wind and rubbing their hands together to sound like falling rain. Try **flickering the lights** to imitate lightning. Then, have them **make the noises of some of the animals** that were on the ark. Feel free to jump in and make some noises of your own! **Explain** that even in the storm, God kept His promise and protected everyone in the ark. Then, He brought Noah, his family, and the animals out safely. **Share** that, even when things are scary, we can always trust God's promises!
